Paul D. Rivas, 92, of Windom, Kansas, passed away unexpectedly at 6:00 p.m., Sunday, May 3rd, 2015, at his home. Paul was born in Waldeck, Kansas, on November 13, 1922, the son of Maria (Perez) and Antonio Rivas. Paul attended the Waldeck grade School, Waldeck, Kansas, Mullinville grade school, and attended McPherson High School. Paul left school to serve in the United States Army. He received his Diploma from McPherson High School on December 17, 2001, as part of the 'Operation Recognition' program for veterans of W.W.II.Paul was Baptized on October 20, 1923 at Velardena, Durango, Mexico. Paul joined the U.S. Army in April of 1941 and honorably served his country during W.W.II. He served as a Technician Fifth Grade in Naples-Foggia Rome-Arno North Apennines thru the Po Valley and finally the Austrian border. He received the American Defense Service Ribbon. After the war, Paul returned home and he began working for Upland Alfafa Mills Inc. He later worked for M.E. White Construction as a driver and for the National Cooperative Refinery Association as a carpenter helper. Paul then moved to Kansas City where he worked for the General Motors Corporation for 37 years and 7 months before retiring. He then returned to McPherson County and spent his remaining years living in Windom, Kansas. Paul was a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 2715 and American Legion Post 24, both of McPherson, Kansas. Paul is survived by his sister, Belen Olson and her husband Clyde, of McPherson, Kansas; 4 grandchildren; his nieces and nephews, Dawn Thiessen and her husband Mike Gould, of Galva, Kansas, Dana Rogers and her husband Larry, of Galva, Kansas, Debbie Hoover and her husband Steve, of Shawnee, Kansas, Toni Lingle, of Fresno, California, Mike Lingle, of North Hollywood, California, Larry Lingle and his wife Lennea, of Hornby Island, Canada, Richard Olson and his wife Debbie, of Frisco, Texas, and Esther Maria McGowan and her husband Kenny, of Roeland Park, Kansas; two great-nephews, other relatives and a host of friends.
